
No? Well let's find out!

READ MARK 15

Starting at the bottom of something can feel intimidating. We might look up and see so many things that we have to overcome. Before Jesus did the most amazing thing ever, he had to start at the bottom too.

Jesus had to climb, literally, to the place of the most extreme pain. In his climb to Calvary, or Golgotha, Jesus would have to overcome every painful challenge and everything was taken from him, including his life.






Jesus was an innocent person but the religious leaders were angry at the way his life had upset their traditions and belief systems. This is why they wanted Jesus to be arrested.

They wanted it so badly that they took matters into their own hands and delivered Jesus to the Pilate.

Pilate was the judge (or governor) that would decide what to do. He had the power to free one of the prisoners but gave the choice to the people that day.

Since they had accused him of so many things, the religious leaders didn't think twice about stirring up the crowd to vote to release another prisoner named Barabbas instead of Jesus.

Then Jesus experienced the lowest place of his life on earth. The whole crowd turned against him (and even one of his closest friends). He was hurt by the hands of the soldiers and experienced so much pain. He was forced to carry a cross to the place where he would suffer so much.



WHY? WHY DID JESUS HAVE TO GO THROUGH ALL OF THIS?

For me and you.

Because what happened after Jesus died would make it possible for him to save us.

But thankfully, the story doesn't end there. Let's find out what happened next in today's Bible story.
